Adding Navigation GPS to your XKE

Have you been driving your XKE and wished it had a navigation GPS?

Here is a real easy solution

- It requires only 5 easy to purchase parts from Amazon \$14
- It easily attaches to you XKE with no drilling, glue, screws etc
- You can easily mount and un mount your navigation device when you get into your car and leave it
- You don't have to carry or store any large ugly parts
- The mounting is almost invisible
- Your navigation is close to eye level and has some degree of shade from the sun.

What are the 5 parts?

The navigation device will be your cell phone The phone mounting will consist of: A top metal magnet bracket 1 thin metal plate with a magnet on each side that holds your cell phone in place A bottom magnet that will attach to the metal plate on the back of your cell phone 1 thin metal plate on the back of you cell phone

More detail on mounting

- The magnets are purchased as a package of several magnets
- The 2 Metal plates are also purchased as a package with several plates.
- 1 magnet is placed on the metal bar on the bottom of the Drop down instrument panel. I placed mine to the left of the clock.
- The Top piece consist of 2 magnets that sandwich a metal plate
- This top piece attaches to the dash panel which on my 71 XKE the dash panel has a metal piece under it so the magnets hold on to it
- The last metal plate is placed on the back of the phone on the bottom between the phone and a cell phone protector

The magnet bar




Top magnet piece 1 magnet on each side of metal plate

Cell phone mounting

- Its not obvious from the photo but the top mounting piece is almost invisible when your in the car
- You place your cell phone behind the top mounting plate and the metal plate on you cell phone will clamp to the bottom magnet and hold you phone in place.
- The top metal plate easily flips out to remove you phone and easily flips back in to hold your phone.
- The Cell Phone will cover the Oil pressure Gage and 3 switches but phone is easily removed for access/viewing if needed.
- Note I've done this on my 1971 Jaguar XKE S3 and I believe all other XKEs will be similar but I haven't tested it on any others. If you try it let me know how it worked for you. *Enjoy*
