

- A Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply must be connected to the vehicle battery during diagnosis / module programming.
- Make sure all ignition ON/OFF requests are carried out; failure to perform these steps may cause damage to control modules in the vehicle.

NOTE:

The Jaguar Land Rover-approved diagnostic tool must be loaded with SDD148.02 v.258 (or later).

- Connect the Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply to the vehicle battery.
- Switch the ignition ON (engine not running).
- Connect the Jaguar Land Rover-approved diagnostic tool to the vehicle and begin a new session.
- Follow the on-screen prompts, allowing the diagnostic tool to read the VIN, identify the vehicle, and initiating the data collect sequence.
- Select **Diagnosis** from the Session Type screen.

- Select the Selected Symptoms tab and then select:
 - Electrical Information and entertainment system - Entertainment system - Audio - Audio sound quality poor
- 7 Select **continue**.
- Select the **Recommendations** tab.
- Select Run to perform the 'Configure existing module -Audio amplifier module' option.
- Follow all on-screen instructions to complete this task, ensuring all Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC) are cleared.
- When all tasks are complete, select the Session tab and then select the Close Session option.
- Disconnect the diagnostic tool and battery power supply from the vehicle.
