

Switch on your mobile phone's Bluetooth® connection using the phone's menu. Make sure that your mobile phone is in Bluetooth® discoverable mode, sometimes referred to as find me mode (see your phone's operating instructions for more information).

Switch the ignition system on; ensure that the touch screen is active.

Home menu shown indicates no phone connected (docked).

From the **Handset** menu initiate a Bluetooth® search.

The Phone is now searching for the vehicle.

When prompted enter code **1313** into phone handset.

Once entered, follow any other phone handset instructions, which may appear, asking for confirmation that you wish to connect to the vehicle.

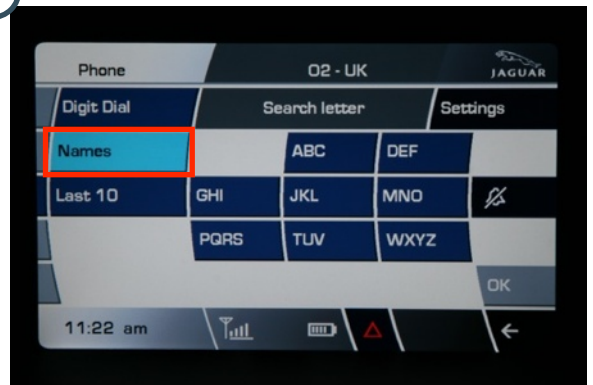
Home menu shown indicates phone connected (paired & docked). Signal strength and battery condition shown on lower edge of screen.

To access your phonebook from the Home menu select **Phone** (**Comms** is shown if JaguarVoice is fitted).

Now select **Names**.
