CONNECTING AN IPOD XK/XF



The Portable Audio Interface connections are located in the cubby box.

A dedicated cable is required to connect an iPod. It will be supplied when PAI is specified.



Connect the iPod to the car. Select **Audio** on the **Home** menu.



This will bring you to the **Audio** main menu. Select **Portable Audio**.



Select **iPod** and you will now be able to control all the functions of the iPod from the Touch-Screen.



Once selected you can now browse and play all your music folders.

Care Points

- Please disconnect the iPod when leaving the vehicle. Failure to do so may result in the iPod battery discharging.
- To maximise playback quality, it is recommended that lossless compression is used for any media files on USB or iPod.
- Some MP3 players have their own file format that is not supported by this system. To use your own MP3 player, you must set it to USB Removable Device or Mass Storage Device mode.
