DVD Headrest Installation Guide

Tools needed – Just a Panel tool (Few pounds on Ebay)

Time - 15 Minutes.


Skill level – Novice.

The Monitor I used was the XTRONS 10-inch HD screen £65 on Ebay. Very reasonably priced and good quality. Comes with both hardwire and cigarette socket power cable. Does have the ability to connect two screens and connects via FM to cars stereo.





 First move desired front seat forward to give more access. I was only installing on the passenger side. To access the rear of the seat, pull gently on the lower side of the panel to disengage the two clips circled RED and pull down, if need be gently use the panel tool to lever the seat back out. I didn't unscrew the two screws holding the bottom of the seat back on and just lent it forward.



2. At this point I unclipped the black strip holding the top of the seat cover on, this makes it easier to slide the power cable underneath.



3. Open the centre console and using the panel tool gentle lift the audio connection panel out, being careful not to damage the clips circled red. Once this is removed carefully slide the power cable through the hole and down between the side panel and the seat. I used a small file just to make a notch in the side of the hole so when replacing the panel, it would not pinch the cable.

 feeding the cable underneath the seat and up through the back. Pulling gentle on the fabric where the headrest pole inters the top of the seat slide the cable out. At this point I replaced the back of the seat.

 The finished product. The DVD player automatically comes on when ignition is on and will turn off when the ignition is off and car is locked.
