CONDITION SUMMARY:

SITUATION:

A customer may report a concern that any or all four door handles will stick in the open position after the door has been opened, the door will not latch and with the ignition on, the door open warnings will be activated.

This version has been issued for a change to the Affected Vehicle Range.

CAUSE:

Raised moulding rib can foul the aperture resulting in the handle sticking open. Handle binding between the door body panel. Suggested Customer Concern Code L08.

ACTION:

Should a customer express concern, follow the Service Instruction outlined below.

SERVICE INSTRUCTION:

Do not disconnect the electrical connector.

Remove the exterior door handle, (see topix section 501-14) follow steps 1 and 2 only.

CAUTION:

Make sure no damage is caused to the vehicle or the vehicles paint work.



Using a suitable tool remove the moulded rib on both sides of the handle, shown in graphic E142772.

- 1 Make sure that all the excess plastic has been fully removed from the door handle.
- Install the exterior door handle, (see topix section 501-14) follow steps 2 and 1.
 - 1 Make sure the door handle works fully.
