Jaguar Model Designations

Information: Some Jaguar literature may refer to a vehicle by its model code designation. Refer to the following list for VIN and model years for each code designation.

Models: X-TYPE All MY

Procedure: Steering wheel angle sensor (SWS) replacement

Information: Prior to ordering an SWS, check the attachment of the coupling at the base of the upper column. A bolted on coupling indicates that the SWS can be removed from the column and replaced. If the coupler is riveted to the base of the upper column, the entire column must be replaced as an assembly.

Equipment: PDU Software

Information: The final versions of software were released for PDU in 2001 as stated in Administration Bulletin 1-125, which should be printed and posted on PDU base station for convenient reference. Due to Service Action S514, S479 should **never** be used to program a customer's car. The software for S479 should only be used to recover an ECM after a WDS reflash failed and then the ECM **must** be programmed with S514 software.

1990-96 MY XJS / 1990-94 MY Sedan Range

Software issue JTP 627/10, released 01/01:

1995-2001 MY XJ Series / 1997-2001 MY XK8 / 2000-2001 MY S-TYPE

Note: Jaguar no longer supports PDU for repair, parts, or software. Existing software should be copied and the master kept in a safe place. Any malfunctioning cables should be repaired and not discarded.
