
## **Removal**

- 1. Raise and support the vehicle.
- 2 . Remove the front road wheels and tires. For additional information, refer to Wheel and Tire (74.20.05)
- 3 . Apply protective tape to the caliper.




CAUTION: Removal of the clips is a delicate procedure, damage will occur if any force is used.

Apply heatshrink or protective tape to the end of the screw-driver.



Remove the anti-rattle spring.


Lever the anti-rattle spring in the center of the spring until either side is released.




CAUTION: Do not allow the brake caliper to hang on the brake hose.

Remove the brake caliper.

- Remove the 2 access plugs.
- Remove the 2 caliper guide pins.
- Tie the brake caliper aside.



- 7 . Release the inboard brake pad from the caliper.
  - Release the clip.



8 . Remove the outboard brake pad.
