Exhaust Gas Recirculation
(EGR) Transfer Pipe – Replace –
Service Action S501MODEL 2000-02 MY XKR
2000-01 MY XJR & VDP SC

Remove and destroy Bulletin 309-S501, dated 4/03.
Replace with this Bulletin.
Revisions are marked with a bar and in **bold text**.

Issue:

A concern has arisen whereby the EGR transfer pipe fitted to vehicles within the above VIN range may crack, due to a combination of normal engine resonance and the form of the pipe. This could result in the illumination of the check engine MIL and customer complaints of excess engine noise.

In order to avoid unnecessary customer inconvenience, the EGR transfer pipe should be replaced with a redesigned EGR transfer pipe on all vehicles within the above VIN range.

Jaguar Cars will be writing to all current owners of vehicles within the above VIN ranges, **who have not had this Service Action performed**, to request them to bring their vehicle in at the first available opportunity to have this work carried out.

Action:

At the next service opportunity, replace the EGR transfer pipe on all 2000-02 MY XKR and 2000-01 MY XJR & VDP SC vehicles within the above VIN range.

Workshop Procedure – XJR and VDP Supercharged Vehicles

1. Open hood and install fender protectors.
2. Open luggage compartment lid and remove battery cover.
3. Disconnect battery.

Note: Ensure the radio code is available before disconnecting the battery.

4. Remove air intake tube/mass air flow sensor/air cleaner cover assembly (see Illustration 1).



5. Remove left and right hand false bulkhead top covers and engine compartment rear cover (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM: section: 501-02).
6. Disconnect evaporative emissions (EVAP) canister purge valve electrical connector (see Illustration 2).



7. Remove the EVAP canister purge valve securing screws (see Illustration 3).



8. Displace EVAP canister purge valve for access.

9. Remove EGR transfer pipe to EGR valve securing screws (see Illustration 4).



10. Reposition EGR transfer pipe for access to the gasket.
11. Remove and discard EGR transfer pipe to EGR valve gasket.
12. Remove EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts (see Illustration 5).



13. Displace and remove EGR transfer pipe from the right hand exhaust manifold studs.
14. Remove gasket from the right hand exhaust manifold studs.
15. Clean the relevant components and mating faces.
16. Install a new gasket to the right hand exhaust manifold studs.
17. Install EGR transfer pipe to the right hand exhaust manifold studs.
18. Install, but do not fully tighten, EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts (see Illustration 6).



19. Adjust EGR transfer pipe (via convolutions) to align with the EGR valve.
20. Install a new gasket between the EGR transfer pipe flange and the EGR valve.
21. While maintaining the gasket in position, align the EGR transfer pipe flange to the EGR valve.

22. Install and tighten EGR transfer pipe to EGR valve securing screws to 21 Nm (see Illustration 7).



23. Final tighten EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts to 21 Nm (see Illustration 8).



24. Align EVAP canister purge valve to mounting position.
25. Install and fully tighten EVAP canister purge valve securing screws to 6 Nm (see Illustration 9).



26. Connect EVAP canister purge valve electrical connector (see Illustration 10).



27. Install left and right hand false bulkhead top covers and engine compartment rear cover (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM, section: 501-02).
28. Re-fill cooling system to the correct level.
29. Install cooling system expansion tank pressure cap.
30. Check accelerator cable adjustment.
31. Install air intake/mass air flow sensor/air cleaner cover assembly (see Illustration 11).



32. Connect battery.
33. Re-align battery cover and close luggage compartment lid.
34. Remove fender protectors and close hood.

Workshop Procedure - XKR vehicles

On all vehicles

1. Open hood and install fender protectors.
2. Open luggage compartment lid and remove battery cover.
3. Disconnect battery.

Note: Ensure the radio code is available before disconnecting the battery.

4. Remove air intake tube/mass air flow sensor/air cleaner cover assembly (see Illustration 12).



WARNING: NEVER REMOVE THE COOLANT EXPANSION TANK PRESSURE CAP WHILE THE ENGINE IS RUNNING. WHEN REMOVING THE CAP USE EXTREME CARE TO AVOID HOT COOLANT OR STEAM BLOWING OUT OF THE COOLING SYSTEM. WAIT UNTIL THE ENGINE HAS COOLED DOWN THEN INSULATE THE CAP USING A SUITABLE CLOTH AND SLOWLY LOOSEN THE CAP UNTIL THE PRESSURE IS RELEASED. WHEN ALL THE PRESSURE HAS BEEN RELEASED SLOWLY REMOVE THE CAP FROM THE TANK. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS INSTRUCTION MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY.

5. Release cooling system pressure.
6. Disconnect throttle body electrical connectors (see Illustration 13).



7. Detach right-hand camshaft position sensor electrical harness (see Illustration 14).



Note: Cap the coolant hose to minimize coolant loss.



Note: Cap the coolant hose to minimize coolant loss.



10. Remove and discard cable tie and disconnect the accelerator outer cable (see Illustration 17).



11. Reposition the accelerator pulley to the full throttle position and disconnect accelerator inner cable (see Illustration 18).



12. Disconnect throttle body electrical connectors (see Illustration 19).



13. Detach left-hand camshaft position sensor electrical harness (see Illustration 20).



14. Remove throttle body securing screws and throttle body and discard the gasket (see Illustration 21).



15. Remove right hand catalytic converter heat shield upper securing screws (see Illustration 22).



16. Remove right hand catalytic converter heat shield to right hand exhaust manifold securing screws and remove heat shield from vehicle (see Illustration 23).



17. Remove EGR transfer pipe heat shield securing screw and remove heat shield from vehicle (see Illustration 24).



18. Remove EGR transfer pipe to EGR valve securing screws (see Illustration 25).



21. Remove EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts (see Illustration 26.).



27. Install, but do not fully tighten, EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts (see Illustration 27).



31. Install and tighten EGR transfer pipe to EGR valve securing screws to 21Nm (see Illustration 28).



32. Final tighten EGR transfer pipe to right hand exhaust manifold securing nuts to 21Nm (see Illustration 29).



33. Align EGR transfer pipe heat shield to vehicle and install but do not fully tighten securing screw (see Illustration 30).



34. Align right hand catalytic converter heat shield to vehicle and install but do not fully tighten securing screws (see Illustration 31).



35. Install and fully tighten right hand catalytic converter heat shield upper securing screws (see Illustration 32).



37. Install a new throttle body gasket and install throttle body. Tighten securing screws to 18-24 Nm (see Illustration 33).



38. Re-install left-hand camshaft position sensor electrical harness (see Illustration 34).



39. Connect throttle body electrical connectors (see Illustration 35).



40. Reposition accelerator pulley to the full throttle position and connect the accelerator inner cable (see Illustration 36).



41. Install accelerator outer cable to mounting bracket and secure using cable tie (see Illustration 37).



Note: Uncap the coolant hose.



Note: Uncap the coolant hose.



44. Re-install right-hand camshaft position sensor electrical harness (see Illustration 40).



45. Connect throttle body electrical connectors (see Illustration 41).



49. Install air intake/mass air flow sensor/air cleaner cover assembly (see Illustration 42).



LOCATION OF LABEL ON DOOR (XK VEHICLES)



Dear Jaguar Owner:

Jaguar Cars and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency have determined that all 2000 and 2001 model year Jaguar XJR and VDP S/C models with 4.0 liter V8 supercharged engines and all 2000 through 2002 model year Jaguar XKR models with 4.0 liter V8 supercharged engines may be emitting pollutants in excess of the Federal and California emission standards. These standards were established to protect the public health and welfare from the dangers of air pollution. Jaguar Cars therefore is conducting an emission service action to replace a component that if cracked may cause elevated levels of oxides of nitrogen. If you are a recipient of this notice, and an owner of one of the above vehicles, this letter is to inform you that your vehicle is included in this emission service action.

What is the problem?

Over time, your vehicle's emission control system may not be able to adequately control the oxides of nitrogen emission levels regulated by State and Federal agencies. The original Exhaust Gas Recirculation (EGR) transfer pipe, under some conditions may split allowing the exhaust gas to escape. This may lead to increased combustion temperatures, which contribute to the formation of NOx. The design of the EGR transfer pipe has been modified to correct the situation. This condition may affect drivability of your vehicle by causing a slight hesitation, poor fuel economy, rough idle, and or lack of power although the most noticeable symptom may be excessive noise under the hood. It will also cause illumination of the Malfunction Indicator Light (MIL) indicating 'Check Engine', and can cause an increase in exhaust emissions. Failure to have this repair performed may lead to increased air pollution.

What will Jaguar do?

Jaguar Cars will install a redesigned EGR transfer pipe and gasket. The repairs take approximately 30 minutes to perform, but due to scheduling, your dealer may require your car for one full business day.

What should you do?

You are requested to contact an authorized Jaguar dealer to arrange for this repair at your earliest convenience. This work will be performed by the dealer free of charge and will increase your vehicle's emission system performance and enhance its reliability. Failure to have this service performed may cause your vehicle to fail an emission test when such tests are required under state or local law.

In order to ensure your full protection under the emission warranty made applicable to your vehicle by Federal law, and your right to participate in future recalls, it is recommended that you have your vehicle serviced as soon as possible. Failure to do so could legally be determined to be a lack of proper maintenance of your vehicle.

Are you an owner of an affected vehicle registered in California?

The State of California requires the completion of this repair prior to vehicle registration renewal. Your Jaguar is subject to these requirements.

When your dealer completes the repair, you will receive a "Vehicle Emission Recall - Proof of Correction" certificate that will indicate that this service action has been performed on your Jaguar.

Please make sure that you get a certificate from the dealer and that you have it when you renew your Jaguar's registration. Dealers will often place the certificate in your vehicle's glove box. It is also important for you to know that the certificate should be returned to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) only if it is requested by the DMV. Otherwise, the certificate is to be held by you for your records.
