
2000 XK8 Drivers Side Door Latch



The windows on my 2000 XK8 are giving me fits as well. First the passenger door window wouldn't go up and seal after closing the door unless I did it with the switch, and now the driver's window goes back up after I open it so that it won't close unless I lower the window back down myself.


Looks like it's the left door handle/lock. They showed me how to raise/lower the windows using the key so I can use the door easier. The right door window works fine after the reset. 

This door latch has 3 switches

I do not have the sequence of the switches and what signal they send. I can take a guess but I do not wish to mislead you with improper information. So, for this reason I will address the switches as open or close.






This switch is controlled by this sliding plastic device.

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This switch is controlled by this leaver. This switch has a two position (single pole changeover switch)





Door latch in the closed position




Door latch in the open /door ajar position



I wanted to reuse the old switch but in the process of removing it I drilled out the stays when all I needed to do was release the stays and the switch would come out. Well installed the switch provided but not sure of its water resistant rating.

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I have not confirmed this information.
